How To Use Paint Masks



Step 1 Use a hobby knife to remove (weed) the negative sections of the paint mask that will not be used. Cut any large negative areas into smaller pieces and take your time weeding.



Step 2 Peel the backing off the clear transfer tape included, position it and rub down on vinyl.



Step 3 Cut out the pieces with your hobby knife or scissors and peel off the backing.



Step 4 Position your mask and rub it down firmly with your finger.



Step 5 Slowly peel off transfer tape and repeat with your other pieces. Marking the center of your body will help you align both sides.



NOTE: Our FASTAPE is also recommended for applying paint masks and works great.



TIP: If you are using a vinyl mask that does not include an outline and you would like one. Simply apply the mask where desired and draw your outline on the outside of the body with a detailing pen. Then cover vinyl mask with 1-2 even coats of Liquid FASMASK (Let dry). Cut out your outline in the FASMASK with a hobby knife. You will also need to cut (trace) around the vinyl mask). Begin by peeling off the first area to paint, etc.
